NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

for the St Stephen-in-Brannel Parish Neighbourhood Plan

1. A Referendum will be held on **Thursday, 3rd October 2024** to decide the question:

“Do you want Cornwall Council to use the neighbourhood plan for St Stephen-in-Brannel Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote or to vote by post or proxy should be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at 4th Floor, South Wing, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, TR1 3AY based on the deadlines set out below:

New applications to vote by post or to cancel or amend an existing postal/proxy vote. Applications for a postal vote can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote	5 pm on Wednesday, 18th September 2024
New applications to vote by proxy. Applications for a proxy vote can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote	5 pm on Wednesday, 25th September 2024
New applications for a Voter Authority Certificate: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate	5 pm on Wednesday, 25th September 2024
Applications for an emergency proxy vote (in cases where unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment occurs after the deadline for proxy applications). The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 25th September 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 25th September 2024.	5 pm on Thursday, 3rd October 2024
